The population of Brazil has surpassed 200 million and about 69% of the population is Roman Catholic. Only 20% profess to be Christian. The official language of Brazil is Portuguese.

You will have the opportunity to hand out the word of God on the streets and house to house. We will also conduct a youth rally as well as evangelistic services, celebrating the 6th anniversary of “New Life Baptist Church” in Taubaté, Brazil.

PREPARATION

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRIP:

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

A United States passport is required. If you do not have one, please apply for one as soon as possible.

Minors must travel with a parent or have the attached permission form signed by both parents.

COVID-19

Trip participants may be required to get a negative COVID test before departure and return. We will update you closer to the trip on COVID related requirements.

CLOTHING

Please do not wear any flashy jewelry or items that would draw unnecessary attention. Do not wear or bring anything that has a sentimental value to it. Do not wear “patriotic” clothing. (We are going to represent Christ not America.) Bring good comfortable walking shoes and church clothes for services.

You will be representing Christ and the churches we will be working with. Modesty is a must. Men should wear khaki type pants or a nice pair of jeans (not faded nor tattered) and collared or polo shirts (no shorts, nor long hair). Ladies should wear below the knee length skirts or dresses (denim allowed) and loose blouses or shirts (no shorts, pants, nor tight or revealing clothing).

LODGING INFORMATION

LODGING

Our lodging in Brazil will be in a hotel. I believe you will be comfortable, and we will make every effort to see that you are taken care of in your place of lodging.

FOOD

For the most part we will be eating out (a fast food type meal for lunch and a nicer sit-down meal for supper each day). Sometimes meals are provided in a home or by the host church.

PREPARATION

Because of additional security measures (baggage inspection, body searches, property confiscation, entry denial, etc.) what you pack is important and could potentially hinder our trip. Therefore, please review the following information carefully.

Carry-on:

The following items are allowed:

- It is wise to pack a pair of clothes in your carry-on in case your checked luggage is misplaced.
- Factory sealed packaged snacks
- Reading materials, camera, sunglasses
- Medications (in prescription bottle with copy of prescription)
- Personal ID, (passport is best to keep on you)
- Light make-up, non-metallic brush

DO NOT bring the following in your carry-on bag:

- Fingernail clippers, files, metallic object of any kind
- Aerosol cans, shaving accessories, etc.
- Unmarked containers
- Lighters, flammables, etc.
- Film, unnecessary items to maintain
- Any liquids must be in 3 oz. containers or smaller and in a 1-quart size zip lock bag.

Checked luggage:

- Please do not over pack. (Remember that you will be responsible for moving all your luggage from place to place.)
- Toiletry items should be in their original marked containers.

2. Personal toiletry items
3. Camera & Alarm Clock
4. Bible, pen and paper
5. Luggage as airlines allows
6. Smile and good attitude
