*Testimony by Pastor Mark Eaton*

It was a tremendous blessing to be part of the recent trip to Guatemala. In many ways, every missions trip has similarities, but I am always pleasantly amazed at how each one seems to take on its own personality. Much of that comes from the makeup of the team.

Some trips have more first-time participants, while others include more people who have been on trips before, and each group brings its own unique spirit and dynamic. One of the blessings of these trips is the friendships that are formed along the way. There are people I have served beside on past trips with whom I may not have much regular contact, yet when we are together again, it feels as though we are able to pick up right where we left off. There is a real family atmosphere on these trips, which is exactly what one should expect when believers come together with a shared love for Christ and a single purpose: furthering the gospel of Jesus Christ.

One of the highlights of the trip for me was the opportunity to spend time with Missionary Josh Hill and his family. It is always a special blessing to be with missionaries on the field, to see their burden firsthand, and to witness the work God is doing through them. It is also a joy to see visitors come to the services and then to witness public professions of faith. Those memories never grow old. They are a reminder that the gospel is still the power of God unto salvation, and that the labor is never in vain in the Lord.

One particular moment from the trip stands out in my mind. We were holding a service at a school, and Pastor Joshua Thompson asked me to watch the boys during the preaching service and choose the one who paid the best attention and behaved the best. To be honest, I do not really enjoy making decisions like that because it is such a hard choice. As I watched the students during the preaching, I found myself praying that their eyes would be opened to the gospel, that their hearts would be tender to the drawing of the Holy Spirit, and that the Lord would help me make the right decision. As I scanned the bleachers filled with young people - many of whom may have never clearly heard the message of salvation by grace through faith alone in the finished work of Christ - my heart broke for them. Of course, some were goofing off and some were whispering back and forth, but there were also many who seemed to be listening very intently. Again and again, my attention was drawn to one boy in particular. When the time came, it was a joy to choose him. Pastor Thompson had told the students that the boy who was selected would receive his hat, and this young man was so excited when he was chosen. I do not know his name, and I will probably never meet him again on this side of heaven, but I have prayed that God will continue to work in his life and that the seeds planted that day will grow, come to full fruition, and bear fruit that remains.

We have been praying and preparing for our **True Victory 2026** project for two years. We are just two months away from putting the plan into action! The World Cup will be staged in 16 cities throughout Canada, the USA, and Mexico. We are working to get one million gospel booklets distributed in all the venue cities to fans from around the world! ## PRODUCTION



We began assembling the gospel booklets in Mexico last November with missionary Chris King and the participating churches in Mexico. In March, we did an assembly project with Faith BC in Richmond, KY. Our home church is now working up the remaining **True Victory** gospel booklets, to be shipped out in May.
